Please find below comments from the Housing & Communities Team at Maidstone Borough Council regarding the above application in respect of amendments made to the previous application reference number **22/505616/OUT**

The only relevant change since our previous comments on 22 December 2022 is the reduction in total units by 5, to provide up to 115 dwellings with a resultant reduction of 2 units to 46 dwellings provided for affordable housing (40% of the total).

This proposal will not impact on the number of dwellings to be provided as First Homes which remains at 12 (25% of the total affordable housing units). However, the number of dwellings to be provided as Social or Affordable rented homes will be reduced from 36 to 34 units.

Following the discussion in our previous response of 22 December 2022, our preferred split of the 46 affordable housing units is shown in the amended table 3 below:
